Beginning Sunday, May 15 and ending Sunday, June 12, motor vehicles will be prohibited from Tookany Creek Parkway between Central Avenue and Jenkintown Road from 1:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. Additionally, through traffic will not be permitted on Beryl Road. Sundays in the Park runs in good weather only.
