Teddy Austin and his family lost everything in a fire at their home during Thanksgiving week. The family was able to escape without harm and is currently living at a local hotel. Robert Austin is a Myers student. Additionally, Mrs. Austin is an employee at Elkins Park School. At this time, staff members at Myers, EP and Cedarbrook are coordinating efforts to purchase a Visa Gift Card so the family can purchase items they need in the near future.

However, the Austin's' could use the following items immediately:

- \* Boys size 12, (possibly slim) clothing; especially a winter jacket, hat and gloves; jeans, warm shirts, PJs, underwear and socks
- \* Men's Medium tops; 38/30 waist/length jeans or slacks; men's Large winter jacket; men's Large; underwear, Size 11 shoe and socks; PJs or sweats
- \* Men's XL Tops, 40/30 waist/length jeans or slacks; 10 1/2 men's shoes; Men's XL underwear, socks, PJs or Sweats
- \* Women's 3X tops, 4X Bottoms; appropriate underwear and socks; 11 Wide Shoe; PJs or Sweats
